



European Aviation Authorities' Chief Medical Officers' Forum

Agreement

1) Membership

The Chief Medical Officer, or equivalent, from each of the Aviation Authorities of the European Union and EASA-associated States.

The Chief Medical Officer, or equivalent, from other European States may apply to attend meetings as an Observer or to be a Corresponding Member only.

2) Terms of Reference

- To promote harmonisation and agree common interpretation of rules.
- To gather and co-ordinate medical evidence, or where evidence is not available, expert medical opinion in support of EASA aeromedical regulation.
- To discuss and offer proposals for changes to EASA aeromedical regulation.
- To provide a forum to discuss inter-State administration procedures and co-operation.
- To communicate aeromedical safety issues to each other and EASA.

3) Objective

To support and maintain safe and consistent aeromedical regulatory practice in Europe.

4) Practical Arrangements

The Forum shall, normally, meet not less than twice per year.

The Forum shall appoint a Chair for a term of office of 2 calendar years.

The Forum shall appoint a Deputy Chair for a term of office of 2 calendar years.

The Forum shall appoint a Secretary for a 2 year period.

Working groups shall be formed for specific tasks on an ad-hoc basis. The working groups may comprise members of the Forum and advisers in aviation medicine specialties.
